

2.1 In consideration of payment of the "Basic Board" fee the Stable agrees to provide the following services:

- a) Use of facilities
- b) Bedding
- c) Stall
- d) Water
- e) Barn Grain (twice daily)
- f) Hay (one flake four times daily)
- g) Individual turnout (minimum of 1 hour per day) seven times per week, weather permitting
- h) Either a half hour private lesson once a week at a scheduled time with the barn owner or booked arena time for you and your coach.

2.2 Monthly "Basic Board" shall begin the first day of each month. If a horse begins "Basic Board" prior to the first day of a month then the Owner will pay "Daily Basic Board" until the first day of a month is reached.

3. Owner Responsibilities

3.1 The Owner will be responsible for all exercise except for "individual turnout" as outlined in Section 2.1. The Owner understands that the Stable cannot be held responsible for any accidents or injuries caused to the horse(s) when turned out individually in a paddock. The Owner shall secure the Stables permission before turning the horse(s) out of the stall and the Owner shall only turn out the horse into designated areas as specified by the Stable.

3.2 The Owner is responsible to keep the horse(s) blankets and halter in safe and good working condition with all repairs completed on a timely basis and at the expense of the Owner. If in the case that a halter is lost, the Owner will be notified and requested to provide a replacement halter. If within three (3) days of notification, the Owner has not supplied the Stable with a replacement halter, a halter will be purchased by the Stable and subsequently charged to the Owner.

3.3 Other than the duties specifically assumed by the Stable in this agreement, shoeing and general care shall be the Owners responsibility. If the Owner requests an employee or agent of the Stable to act beyond the scope of the Stable's duties as described in this agreement, including but not limited to act in some way in caring for, training, treating, assisting in care or treatment, the administration of medication, or dressing of wounds, it shall be understood that neither the Stable, not the employee or agent of the Stable who agrees to assist the Owner shall be liable to the Owner for negligence, and Owner shall defend and hold harmless the Stable and its employees or agents from any claim bought by a third party arising out of the undertaking.

4. Rules and Regulations

4.1 The Owner agrees to abide by and conform to all rules and regulations as posted from time to time by the Stable. The Owner accepts full responsibility for the safety of any of his/her visitors and /or riders they may bring onto the Stable premises, and shall ensure that all visitors abide by such rules and regulations. The Owner agrees to not provide the public lessons or training on the side for any reason with his/her horse(s) at/on/in this facility as a boarder. Any questions, service charges or discrepancies, the Owner agrees, will be addressed in writing for successful, workable solutions. All riders under the age of 18, visiting or otherwise, must wear correct and proper headgear and footwear.

4.2 The Owner shall use the indoor arena or outdoor arena as riding areas only. Riding will not be permitted in or on, the other areas of the Stable including the driveway. The Owner understands that the Stable will not supervise such riding. The Owner will not disturb riding classes for the purpose of riding.

5. Risk of Loss

5.1 While the horse is boarded at the Stable, the Stable shall not be liable for any sickness, disease, theft, death or injury suffered by the horse(s) or any other cause of action arising from or

connection to the boarding of (these) horse(s). All risks are assumed by the Owner. All costs, no matter how catastrophic, connected with boarding are borne by the Owner. The Owner agrees to hold the Stable, its employees and agents harmless from any claim resulting from damage or injury caused by the Owner, the Owner's horse, or the Owner's licensees or invitees.

5.2 It is recommended by the Stable, that the Owner obtains an insurance policy for horse(s) or personal tack. The horse(s) and all tack and equipment of the Owner and lodged on the Stable premises shall be at the sole risk of the Owner, who assumes all responsibility for the insuring of the horse(s), tack and equipment Owned by him/her, while on the Stable premises. The Owner will be held responsible for any damages caused by horse or Owner and will be required to pay for damages at the discretion of the Stable.

Indemnity

The owner agrees to carry personal liability insurance coverage on said horse(s).

6. Emergency Care

If medical treatment is needed, the Stable will attempt to contact the Owner, but in the event the Owner is not reached, the Stable has the authority to secure emergency veterinary and /or blacksmith care. The Owner is responsible to pay all costs relating to this care. The Stable is authorized as the Owner's agent to arrange billing to the Owner.

7. Vaccination and Parasite Control Program

7.1 The Stable agrees to implement a vaccination and parasite control program, consistent with recognized standards. Incoming horse(s) will be subject to the parasite control program on arrival. The Owner will be billed for all vaccination and parasite control charges.

7.2 The stable may change the vaccination and parasite control programs from time to time after consultation with the stable veterinarian

7.3 The Owner may request additional vaccinations and parasite control over and above the standard stable program.

8. Notice Of Leaving

8.1 The Owner, on monthly "Basic Board", agrees to give the Stable one (1) months written notice , prior to the first (1st) day of the month, of departure of the horse(s), or in lieu of the one (1) months written notice, the Owner will be billed to that date of departure plus one (1) months boarding fees. Any and all outstanding charges must be paid in full by the Owner before the horse(s) may leave the Stable. The Owner cannot assign this agreement unless the stable agrees in writing. There will be a 2% interest added to bills over 30 days.

8.2 The Stable reserves the right to notify the Owner within seven (7) days of the horse(s) arrival if the horse(s), in the Stable's opinion, is (are) deemed dangerous or undesirable of a boarding facility and in such a case, the Owner is responsible for removing the horse(s) within Seven (7) days and for all fees incurred during the horse(s) stay at the Stable. After all fees have been paid, the Agreement is concluded.

8.3 The Stable agrees to give the Owner, one (1) months written notice, prior to the first (1st) day of the month of departure, of the termination of this agreement.

9. Right of Lien

The Stable has the right of lien as set forth in the law of the Province of Nova Scotia for the amount due for board and additional agreed upon services and shall have the right, without process of law, to retain said horse(s) until the indebtedness is satisfactorily paid in full.

10. Termination

Either party may terminate this agreement. In the event of a default, the wronged party has the right to recover attorney's fees and court costs, resulting from this failure of either party to meet a material term of this agreement.

11. Health

The Owner warrants that the horse(s) shall be free from infectious, contagious or transmissible disease at the time the horse is first boarded. The Owner shall immediately advise the Stable in person if the Owner is advised, or has reason to believe, the horse(s) is infectious, contagious, or has a transmissible disease at any time during the period of this agreement.
